Learned senior counsel for respondent No.1 has produced a copy of the order dated 27.05.2016 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in CACP No.16 of 2016, whereby the order dated 21.04.2016 passed by this Court holding the petitioners guilty of having committed contempt of Court, has been set aside on the ground that the order passed by the Supreme Court on 21.04.2015 directing the State to take immediate steps to adjust the petitioners herein against suitable posts within or outside the district where they were earlier working, stands complied with.

In the light of the Division Bench order dated 27.05.2016 passed by the said Court, the present contempt petition does not survive and, therefore, the same is disposed of as infructuous.
