Short affidavit of Gurdarshan Singh Brar, Deputy Director office of Director Public Instructions (Colleges), Punjab, dated 29.4.2016, filed in Court is taken on record. It has been stated therein that the second instalment of grant-in-aid has been paid to the petitioners on 18.4.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that as per the details given in the affidavit, the amount has been paid to the petitioners. However, in case still any amount is left due, the petitioners may be given liberty to represent to the respondent.

The petition is disposed of with liberty, as prayed for. In case the petitioners make representation and finally the competent authority finds that there is more amount due to be paid to the petitioners, the needful shall be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt thereof.
