AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Learned counsel for the respondent has placed on record copy of the order dated 17.10.2016 passed by the Deputy Commissioner (S&R) Department of Food & Public Distribution, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, Government of India, in compliance with the order dated 24.09.2016 passed by this Court. He, on this basis, contends that the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioners does not dispute the said fact.
