This petition is filed for the alleged disobedience of the order dated 7.07.2015(Annexure P-1) passed in CRM-M No. 19769 of 2015. The petitioner had filed criminal misc. petition for seeking a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect his life, liberty and property which was threatened by respondents No. 4 to 6.

This petition was disposed of by this Court with the direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, Punjab to look into the grievances of the petitioner unfolded in the representation dated 29.05.2015 and in case any substance is found then to take action in accordance with law within 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the said order.

The SSP, Tarn Taran has filed his reply by way of an affidavit in which it is averred that the representation made by the petitioner was got investigated through DSP,

Sub Division, Patti who did not find any cause of action in the complaint made by the petitioner and on the basis thereof, order was passed by the SSP Tarn Taran on 29.10.2015.

Since the direction issued by this Court has been duly complied with by the respondent, therefore, I do not find any merit in the present petition. The petitioner, may if so advised, avail his other remedy in accordance with law, if it is available to him.
