AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging contempt of the order dated 07.12.2015 passed by this Court, whereby directions were issued to the Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Society, Hisar to decide the election petition preferred by one Rajpal, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

On a categorical question put by the Court to the counsel for the petitioner as to when the order passed by this Court dated 07.12.2015 was conveyed to the respondent, the counsel has no answer thereto. Since the order passed by this Court was not conveyed to the respondent, there is no question of contempt and in any case, the respondent has proceeded to

having been complied with by the respondent, there would be no contempt made out of the order, as is alleged.

The present contempt petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
