AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging violation of the order dated 22.12.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Company Court in CA Nos. 803-804 of 2015 in CP No. 115 of 2002 titled as The Plantation Investors Protection Society vs. M/s Golden Projects Ltd.

A perusal of the said order would show that no time limit has been fixed and what has been stated by the Company Court is that the Committee shall ensure that the relevant record is made available to the representative of the Company. Thereafter, the case was adjourned after passing of this order on 22.12.2015 to 29.01.2016. The reply is stated to have been given by the Committee, which has been reproduced in para-8 of the contempt petition and as is apparent from the said reply, the matter is pending before the Supreme Court awaiting clarification. Apart from that,

the counsel has, very fairly, stated that the factum of non-making available of the records by the Committee, in compliance with the order dated 22.12.2015 passed by the Company Court, was brought to the notice of the Court but no further steps have been taken by the Court thereon.

If that be so, no contempt is made out in the present case as the Court, which has passed the order, has chosen not to take further action in pursuance to the order dated 22.12.2015.

The present contempt petition is, therefore, dismissed.
