AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the respondents has submitted two separate traffic checking reports, one is of the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, of vehicles challaned w.e.f. 01.04.2015 to 31.05.2016 and the other is of the Inspector General of Police, Traffic, Punjab, for the period 01.01.2016 to 30.09.2016. A perusal of the same indicates that efforts are being made to challan the auto rickshaws/three wheelers which are plying without permit beyond the Municipal Limits.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of with directions to the respondents to continue with the process of checking and challaning such auto rickshaws/three wheelers which are plying beyond the Municipal Limits without permit. In case the effort on the part of the respondents is found to be lacking, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file a fresh contempt petition for non-compliance of the order passed by this Court.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged, subject to above.
