Rajesh Bindal, J.

The petitioner alleges willful violation of the order passed by this Court on 5.7.2005 in LPA No. 108 of 2005, filed by the petitioner, where the parties were directed to maintain status quo with regarding to nature and possession of the land in dispute.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that after constitution of Municipal Council at Nawanshahar in violation of the aforesaid order passed, the same has been mutated in the name of Municipal Council, hence, the respondents deserve to be summoned for punishment for violation of the aforesaid order.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, I do not find any reason to entertain the present petition as the change of ownership of land is not on account of any action by an individual, rather by operation of law on account of constitution of Municipal Council, in which the area in question now falls. It is not determination of rights between the parties. Hence, there is no violation of the order passed.

For the reasons mentioned above, I do not find any reason to entertain the present petition. The same is accordingly dismissed.
