Short reply by way of affidavit of R.S.Poonia, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Rohtak on behalf of respondent no.1 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

The order dated 10.1.2013, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation (attached as Annexure P-2 with the writ petition) by passing a speaking order within a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed. It is further stated in the reply that arrears have also been paid to the petitioner.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents in the event of any shortfalls. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
