This petition is filed for the alleged disobedience of the order dated 1.5.2012 more particularly in respect clause IV of the order, which read thus: -

“Meanwhile, promotion, if any, shall be subject to the decision to be taken with respect to the petitioner’s claim.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that Karamjit Singh, Head Draftsman has been promoted to the post of Sub Divisional Officer (Public Health) but his case of promotion has not been considered.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after examining the available record, am of the considered opinion that there is no merit in the present petition because the direction issued by this Court that if any promotion is made, it would be subject to the claim of the petitioner,

therefore, it does not mean that the petitioner has also to be promoted before the other person has to be promoted.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
