Rajesh Bindal, J.

This order will dispose of COCP No. 2788, 2873, 2875, 2904, 2906 of 2015, 233, 507 and 508 of 2016.

Learned counsel for the respondent submitted that entire payment due to the petitioners on account of the bills already approved, has been transferred in their bank accounts vide pay order dated 7.4.2016. The bank has been instructed to credit the same in the account of the petitioners. This may be reflected in their accounts in a day or so.

In the affidavit filed earlier, for delay in compliance of the order, unconditional apology was tendered. While accepting the same, the present petitions are disposed of, however, with liberty to the petitioners to get the same revived in case the payments, as stated by learned counsel for the respondents, are not credited in the accounts of the petitioners. In that eventuality, the respondents shall be held guilty of contempt and shall be heard only on punishment.
