It is not in dispute that the order passed by this Court has been complied with and for delay, unconditional apology has been tendered. Though services of the petitioner have been regularised, however, the consequential benefits are yet to be released.

Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions from Balbir Singh Panwar, Establishment Officer, Municipal Corporation, Faridabad, submitted that all the consequential benefits shall be granted to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.

The order passed by this Court has been complied with and for delay in compliance, unconditional apology has been tendered. While accepting the same and granting two weeks time from today for granting all the consequential benefits, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to get the same revived in case the needful is not done within the stipulated period. In that eventuality, the respondents shall be heard only on quantum of punishment.
