Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that the petitioner has already been awarded 25 marks under the heading land in terms of the directions issued by this Court which is subject to decision in LPA filed against the judgment of the learned Single Judge. He further submitted that field investigation will start next week. The entire exercise will be over within a period of two months. In case the petitioner is found eligible, he will be granted letter of intent. In case any objection is found during field investigation, a speaking order shall be conveyed to him.

With the aforesaid stand taken by the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to get same revived in case the order passed is not complied with.
