AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner has asserted that the respondents have not complied with the order dated 27.11.2012 (Annexure P-2) passed by this Court in CWP No.17286 of 2011, titled as 'Vijay Prabhakar Vs. Union of India & others'. He contends that no arrears have been paid to the petitioner.

This assertion of the counsel for the petitioner is specifically denied by the learned senior counsel for the respondents who states that the arrears amounting to ₹ 17,760/- have been paid to the petitioner on the post of Senior Commercial Clerk in his salary for the month of July, 2014, with reference to note of Annexure P-4, dated 07.03.2014. This assertion of the counsel for the respondents is disputed by the counsel for the petitioner.

In the light of the statement made by the learned senior counsel for the respondents, this Court is satisfied that no contempt is made out against the respondents. In case the petitioner is aggrieved or there is some other due which the petitioner is entitled to which has not been paid by the respondents, he may avail of his remedy in accordance with law including filing of execution proceedings.

The contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
