The affidavit dated 13.7.2015 would indicate that licenses of erring firms have been cancelled and criminal complaints have been preferred against them. It is further submitted that against erring officials chargesheets have been issued and regular inquiries have been initiated.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, I am of the view that instant petition needs to be disposed of with a direction to the respondents that regular inquiry against erring officials be completed as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
