Short affidavit of Varinder Kumar Goel, Executive Engineer, Mansa Division I.B., Jawaharke, dated 6.4.2016, filed in Court is taken on record.

The writ petition filed by the petitioner was disposed of directing consideration of his representation regarding the payment of the bills for the work executed by him.

In the affidavit filed today in Court, it is stated that representation was disposed of on 25.8.2015. A sum of ₹ 66.78 lacs was found to be due to the petitioner on account of completed work and the payment has already been made.
