RAJESH BINDAL, J.

With the consent of counsel for the parties, the main petition which was adjourned sine die on 16.2.2016, is taken on board.

Counsel for the parties do not dispute the fact that in view of the judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court dated 31.3.2016, in Civil Appeal Nos. 8959 and 8962 of 2013, the prayer made in the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that in terms of the order passed by this Court on 16.2.2016, the Life Insurance Corporation of India, had deposited about a sum of ₹ 34 lacs. In view of the judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court, the amount be refunded so as to enable the corporation to pay the amount to the petitioners in terms of the directions issued by Hon'ble the Supreme Court.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the order passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court giving liberty to the Corporation to withdraw the amount deposited in this Court to enable it to pay to the employees, the Registry is directed to refund the amount already deposited by the Corporation.
