AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order dated 01.06.2016 passed by this Court, according to which, the respondents were mandated to deposit the amount with the Bank which shall be invested on the account and subject to further orders. Counsel contends that the respondents have not complied with the said order. It has also been stated by the counsel for the petitioner that the writ petition preferred by the respondents has been withdrawn on 21.11.2016.

The interim order, which has been passed by this Court, has merged with final order and, therefore, if the petitioner had not availed of the benefit, which was conferred upon on the basis of the said order, then no contempt has been committed by them.

In the light of the subsequent developments in the form of

withdrawal of the writ petition, the present contempt petition cannot be said to be made out against the respondents and, therefore, the same stands dismissed.
