Counsel for the respondents, on instructions from
Mr. Nitin Saggi, Clerk, Ranjit Sagar Dam, Shahpur Kandi, Pathankot, states
that petitioners No. 2 and 3 have been offered appointment as per the Policy
and the claim qua petitioner No. 1 has been rejected.

Counsel for the petitioners states that there are certain
documents which the petitioners could not supply to the authorities which
have to be taken into consideration and would entitle petitioner No. 1 to the
benefit of the policy. He prays for two weeks' time to supply the documents
to the Chief Engineer, Ranjit Sagar Dam-respondent No. 3, who shall, if
such a representation along with the documents, is submitted within a
period of two weeks, consider the same and pass a speaking order within a
period of six weeks from the date of submission of
representation/documents.

The contempt petition stands disposed of accordingly.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
