Reply by way of short affidavit of Shri Rajinder Kumar, Executive Engineer, Provincial Division, PWD (B&R) Branch, Ludhiana, respondent herein, has been filed in Court, according to which, an amount of Rs.12,16,851/- has been released to the petitioner vide cheque No.976980 dated 10.10.2016. Respondent, who is present in Court, has stated that he had received the sanctioned amount on 08.10.2016 and has released the amount due to the petitioner after deduction of taxes on 10.10.2016. Reference has also been made by the counsel for the respondent to the receipt dated 10.10.2016, wherein, it has been mentioned that the amount has been received against full and final payment for the work of upgrading and maintenance of Sherpur to Ludhiana Chandigarh Road, PB-1008 (Section Samrala to Jhar Sahib) under PMGSY 12.95 K.M.
