The writ petition filed by the petitioner was disposed of on 18.8.2015 and he was held entitled for the interest on the belated settlement of pensionary benefits @ 9% per annum. It is not in dispute that the respondent has paid a sum of ₹ 1,66,204/- on account of interest on belated payments of retiral dues. The petitioner claims that certain amount is due as there is calculation error.

Learned counsel for the respondent submitted that he will get the account checked and if any further amount is found to be paid, the same shall be paid to the petitioner within a period of two weeks.
