Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that in compliance of the order passed by this Court dated 25.7.2014, speaking order has been passed deciding the legal notice dated 28.1.2014 and all the petitioners except petitioner No.27-Partap Singh, who has expired, are still working and they have been allotted G.P. Fund account numbers and hence all the petitioners have automatically become eligible for the benefit of pension on old pattern. It is also submitted that the cost imposed by this Court of ₹20,000/- has been deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority vide receipt No.924022 dated 7.11.2016.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition has become infructuous.
