This petition is filed for the alleged disobedience of the order dated 3.06.2016 in which direction was issued to the respondents to re-consider the case of the petitioner for pre-mature release by passing a speaking order within four months. Further directed that if the case of the petitioner for premature release is not decided within the stipulated time, the petitioner shall be released on parole.

The case set up by the petitioner is that though the order passed by this Court on 3.06.2016 to re-consider the case of the petitioner for premature release but no order, deciding his case of pre-mature release is passed within prescribed time, therefore, the petitioner was entitled to be released on parole.

After notice, respondents have filed reply alongwith order (Annexure R-1) dated 22.09.2016, passed within 4 months from the date of passing the order of this Court, by which the case of the petitioner has been rejected and recommendation has been made to the State Level Committee

to re-consider his case after completion of 20 years of total sentence as per policy dated 12.04.2002.

In view thereof, I do not find any merit in the present case, the same is hereby dismissed.
