AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order passed by this Court on 02.04.2013 in CWP No.22330 of 2012.

Perusal of the reply would indicate that the respondents have removed the impediment with regard to the path and now it has been clearly mentioned that the path has been provided having Khasra No.519. It has further been mentioned that by an inadvertent mistake at the time of consolidation, this path could not be connected to the *phirni* and it touches Khasra No.90/21 in which *gadda khad* has been allotted. The details further have been given in para 1 of the affidavit. In para 3, the details have been given with regard to the allotment of alternative land and it has further been mentioned that the possession of Khasra No.90//24/5 and 90//23/29 has been delivered to the concerned private respondents and mutation entered thereof and Khasra No.90//21/1(0-2) and 90//21/2(west)(0-1) are incorporated in the path and as such now there is no impediment to have access to the cremation ground.

In view of the reply which has been filed by the respondents,

the present contempt petition does not survive.

The same is disposed of as infructuous.

In case the statement as given by the respondents in the reply/affidavit is found to be not correct, petitioner may file an appropriate application by supporting the same with documentary evidence for revival of the contempt petition.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged subject to above.
