AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Separate replies on behalf of respondent No.2 and respondent No.3 have been filed in Court, which are taken on record. As per the reply of respondent No.2-Director, Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab, the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with. Even the consequential benefits, on consideration of the claim of the petitioner qua the retiral benefits, have been released, details whereof have been mentioned in para 2 of the affidavit.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous. In case the petitioner has any grievance with regard to his claim, he may submit a representation to respondent No.2 within a period of six weeks. If such a representation is made, the same shall be

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considered and decided by passing a speaking order by respondent No.2 within a period of eight weeks from the date of submission of such representation. In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within a period of four weeks thereafter.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged, subject to above.
