AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner, very fairly, concedes that the order passed by this Court has been complied with. He further states that the details of the calculations as to how the amounts have been reached, payments of which have been received, are not known to the petitioner.

Counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Sh. Bhudher Singh, Junior Assistant, DPI (EE), Punjab, states that the calculations, as made, will be handed over to the petitioner within a period of six weeks. In case the petitioner is not satisfied with the same, he may move a representation to the District Education Officer, Gurdaspur within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the calculations. If such a representation is made the same shall be considered and a decision taken by

the District Education Officer within a further period of six weeks. In case some claim is found due, the same shall be released to the petitioner within a further period of four weeks.

In the light of above statement of the counsel, as given on instructions, the contempt petition stands disposed of in above terms.
