AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order dated 11.09.2015 passed in CRM-M No.30980 of 2015, titled as 'Naresh Kumar Vs. State of Haryana & others', wherein, direction was issued to the Superintendent of Police, Jind, to look into the representation dated 10.08.2015 submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate action as required by law to obviate the impression of any faulty or incomplete investigation. In pursuance to the said direction, the investigation has been carried out by the respondents and it has been found that Jagbir Singh, Sub-Inspector, who initiated the investigation after the registration of the FIR, has not been careful and rather, negligent in the process resulting in the imposition of stoppage of three increments with cumulative effect. The DNA sample which has been received by ASI Bhan Ram from the doctor

and not deposited with the Malkhana because of which sample could not be

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sent to the Forensic Science Laboratory for the purpose for which the sample was taken, against him, disciplinary proceedings were initiated and as he had retired from service, cut in pension has been ordered. It has further been submitted that the supplementary challan has also been submitted in Court on 01.07.2016 and the matter is now pending in the Court at the stage of prosecution evidence.

In the light of the above, this Court is satisfied that the order passed by this Court has been complied with rendering the present contempt petition infructuous. Disposed of as such.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
