This petition is filed for the alleged disobedience of the award of the Labour Court dated 07.02.2013. The said award was challenged by the State by way of CWP No.8944 of 2013, which was dismissed on 11.12.2014. Thereafter, the present petition was filed.

After notice, the respondents have filed the reply stating therein that the award of the Labour Court has been duly complied with. However, counsel for the petitioner is not satisfied with the reply of the respondents.

Be that as it may, in case the award passed by the Labour Court is not complied with, as stated, the petitioner has the remedy to file the writ petition for execution of the said award and insofar as the present petition is concerned, it is not maintainable.
