The petitioner had approached this Court for the issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 4, arrayed in the petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C, to complete investigation and to submit status report/challan, pertaining to case bearing FIR No. 103 dated 14.07.2013 under Sections 420/193/177 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

The said petition was disposed of by this Court without expressing any opinion on merits of the controversy with a direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to look into the matter in the light of representation dated 21.11.2013(Annexure P-2), already stands submitted and to take further steps as warranted, strictly in accordance with law.
