In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 28.07.2014 in CWP No.14704 of 2014, titled as 'Naresh & another Vs. Chandigarh Administration & others', an order dated 25.05.2016 (Annexure R-2) has been passed by the Estate Officer, U.T., Chandigarh, according to which, the claim of the petitioners has been found to be not fulfilling the mandate of The Chandigarh Small Flats Scheme, 2006, rendering them ineligible for consideration of the benefit of the said scheme.

In view of the above, the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with. Disposed of as infructuous. Petitioners, if aggrieved, may avail of their remedy against the order dated 25.05.2016 (Annexure R-2), in accordance with law.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
