The writ petition filed by the petitioner was allowed on 25.9.2013 directing release of retiral dues within a period of one month and on failure interest was to be paid @ 8% per annum from the date of retirement till payment.

It is not in dispute that the principal amount has already been paid, however, there being delay in payment thereof, the interest has to be paid.

Learned counsel for the respondents stated that the amount on interest shall be paid within a period of two weeks. The amount is to be paid by the Sub-Divisional Officer (Civil), Rohtak.

Keeping in view the stand taken by learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition is disposed of, however, with liberty to the petitioner to get the same revived, in case the amount of interest is not paid within a period of two weeks from today and in that event respondent no. 1 shall be guilty of contempt of this Court and shall be heard only on the quantum of punishment.
