Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that vide order dated 21.04.2016, costs of ₹5,000/- each was imposed upon respondent nos.1 to 3, which was ordered to be deposited with the State within a period of one month.

Counsel for respondents No.1 to 3 has produced the receipts showing deposit of the costs of ₹5,000/- each by respondents no.1 to 3 in the Government Treasury. He has also paid, a sum of ₹30,000/- today in the Court towards mesne profits calculated upto 29.08.2016, to the counsel for the petitioners.

In view thereof, the present petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such. However, the respondents are directed to pay future annual mesne profits to the petitioners regularly and in case the mesne profits are not paid, the petitioners will be at liberty to file an application for revival of the present contempt petition.
