Learned senior counsel for the petitioner very fairly states that the order passed by this Court has been complied with and a detailed order dated 04.11.2016 has been passed, whereby the land of the petitioner measuring 7 kanal 14 marla comprising in Khasra No.11//17/1 (5-1) and 25/2 (2-13) has been released subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned in the letter dated 02.02.2016 and the High Court order dated 07.05.2014. He further states that requirements as referred to above dated 02.02.2016 and 07.05.2014 have already been fulfilled by the petitioner.

Counsel for the State states that if that be the position, the Notification under Section 48 of the Land Acquisition Act, will be issued within a period of four weeks from today.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the State,
the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to

the petitioner to revive the same, in case the requisite Notification is not issued by the respondents within the time as stated by the counsel.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
