Counsel for the petitioner states that by and large the benefits have been granted to the petitioner as per the judgment dated 25.07.2014 of this Court passed by Division Bench in Civil Writ Petition No.2297 of 2014 (*Ashok Kumar vs. Union of India and others*), contempt of which is alleged. He states that the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous, however, liberty may be granted to the petitioner in case some other relief which he is entitled to, has not been released.

In view of the above statement made by counsel for the petitioner, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation to the competent authority within a period of two weeks in case any other claim is pending with the respondents as a consequence of the order passed by this Court.
