In pursuance to the order dated 22.3.2016, Keshni Anand Arora, Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, School Education Department, Haryana, is present in person in Court. Short reply by way of her affidavit filed in Court today is taken on record. The order passed on 31.3.2016 in compliance to the directions issued by this Court has been placed on record alongwith the reply filed. For delay in compliance, unconditional apology has been tendered. In para-3 of the affidavit, it has been stated that whatever reliefs were admissible to all the petitioners have been granted. The reasons on account of which the petitioners are not entitled to revised gratuity, leave encashment and commutation of pension on account of notional revision of pay scale have been assigned in the order.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and accepting the apology tendered for delay in compliance of the direction issued by this Court, the present petition is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioners to avail of their appropriate remedy against the order dated 31.3.2016.
