AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASHI, J. (Oral):

The grievance in the present contempt petition is the non-compliance of the order passed by this Court in CWP No.14525 of 2014, titled as 'M/s Gagan Builders Vs. State of Haryana & others', decided on 25.07.2014, wherein, direction was issued to the respondents to look into the representation dated 17.02.2014 of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case, some amount is found due, the same be released forthwith.

It is apparent from the Enquiry Report of the City Magistrate, Sirsa, dated 29.08.2014 (Annexure P-10) that the total amount payable to

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the petitioner was `16,70,305/- (`8,38,980/- as labour work and `8,31,325/- for supply of material), out of which an amount of `12,86,829/- has already been received to the petitioner. On perusal of the reply which has been filed by respondents No.3 and 4, it is apparent that the balance amount of `3,83,476/- has also been paid to the petitioner vide cheque No.700148 dated 17.09.2014. In the light of the above fact, it is apparent that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with contempt of which has been alleged.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition stands disposed of. Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
