Counsel for the petitioner, in the light of the payments, which have been received by the petitioner, which, according to the petitioner's counsel, are not the one which she is entitled to on pay revision, prays for withdrawal of the present contempt petition with liberty to file a representation to the respondents claiming therein due entitlement of the petitioner, which representation will be submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today.

In case such a representation is submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today to the Secretary, Punjab State Social Welfare Advisory Board-respondent No. 2, the same shall be considered and decided by respondent No. 2 by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks thereafter. The details with regard to the

calculations made qua the fixation/revision of the pay of the petitioner as also the calculation of the arrears be also supplied to the petitioner.

As per the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present contempt petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for with the observations, as made above.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
