It is not in dispute that the petitioner has been regularised w.e.f. 1.4.2013 the date from which his juniors were regularised. The petitioner claims that he was to be paid arrears of salary as was paid to the other similarly situated persons. However, there being no specific directions of this Court, the same cannot be subject matter of contempt jurisdiction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail of appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
