The order dated 27.5.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondent no.2 consider and decide the representation made by the petitioner (attached as Annexure P-4 with the writ petition) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order so passed in case she is dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
