This order will dispose of COCP Nos. 3330 of 2014, 117, 249, 503, 2989 to 2991 of 2015 as common question of law and facts are involved.

In the present bunch of petitions, non compliance of the judgment of this Court passed in CWP No.15479 of 2012, has been alleged.

The stand of the State is that in Special Leave Petition filed before Hon'ble the Supreme Court, the proceedings in the contempt petition filed allegedly for non-compliance of the aforesaid judgment have been stayed.

Considering the aforesaid fact, in my opinion, the present petitions can be disposed of at this stage, however, with liberty to the petitioners to get the same revived in case after decision of the matter pending before Hon'ble the Supreme Court, the relief, if any admissible to the petitioners, is not granted.
