The order dated 17.02.2012, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation (attached as Annexure P-3 with the writ petition) within a period of 1 month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed. It is further submitted in the reply that payment on account of leave encashment and GIS have been made to the petitioner whereas papers regarding pension and gratuity have been sent to AG, Haryana for sanction. This is not the satisfaction of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and noticing compliance of the orders of the writ Court, instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in the event of any dissatisfaction. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
