MAHESH GROVER.J.

After the order of the writ court, the competent authority has passed a fresh order. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that this order is similar to the one which was passed earlier, and therefore, there has been an attempt to undermine the authority of this Court.

On due consideration of the matter, I am of the opinion that the competent authority has granted a reconsideration to the issue raised by the petitioner. If the reasoning reflected in the order is to the dissatisfaction of the petitioner, the same would be a subject matter of challenge. It cannot be construed that by passing an order which may be somewhat but not totally similar to the one passed earlier, and quashed by this court, would be a ground to proceed against the respondent for contempt

particularly when a reasoning has been given to support the observations made by the competent authority.

The petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to impugn the order so passed.
