Petitioner had approached this Court with a grievance that the order dated 27.01.2014 passed by this Court in *CWP No.1421 of 2014* titled as *Satpal Versus The State of Punjab and others* had not been complied with by the respondents.

As per the reply/compliance report which has been filed by way of affidavit of Shri S.S. Bains, IAS, Special Secretary and Director, Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab, the case of the petitioner has been duly considered as per the directions issued by this Court and the legal notice decided vide order dated 16.07.2015 (Annexure R-1) which has been forwarded to the petitioner.
