Separate reply by way of affidavits of respondent nos. 1 and 2 dated 5.5.2016, filed in Court are taken on record. Copies furnished to counsel for the petitioners.

The petitioners allege violation of the interim order dated 8.3.2007 passed in RSA No. 747 of 2007, where the parties were directed to maintain status quo at the time of admission of the appeal. In response the stand is that the respondents have neither alienated the suit land nor interfered into the possession of the petitioners.

Considering the contents of the affidavits, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the prayer made in the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
