Counsel for the respondent has filed a short reply by way of affidavit of the Director, Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab, whereby, the claim of the petitioner as made in the representation has been decided vide order dated 24.11.2016 (Annexure R-1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that no interest has been paid on the delay as the arrears have been released to the petitioner qua the benefit of Assured Career Progression Scheme, which benefit has now been granted to the petitioner.
