This petition is filed for the alleged disobedience of the order dated 27.05.2014(Annexure P-2) in which the following direction was issued:

“In view of the above pleadings, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Panipat-respondent No. 4 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 11.04.2014(Annexure P-4) served by the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

State counsel has submitted that the legal notice served by the petitioner has been decided against the petitioner on 9.02.2016. however, counsel for the petitioner submits that the legal notice has not been decided by taking into consideration the order passed in CWP No. 9660 of 2011 decided on 17.09.2013.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and after perusing the available record, am of the considered opinion that there is no such direction issued by this Court to decide the legal notice of the petitioner in view of the decision rendered in CWP No. 9660 of 2011 but since the order has been passed in the legal notice against the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner may, if so advised, challenge the said order in accordance with law. As far as, this petition is concerned, it has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
