Mr. Jaspal Singh Aulakh has referred to the reply which has been filed to the contempt petition. Reference has been made to para 3 and 4 of the same, according to which on consideration of the representation of the petitioner dated 06.08.2015, wherein she claimed LTC, was accepted vide Order No.335-37 dated 31.05.2016 (Annexure R-1) holding her entitled to LTC. Further the Block Primary Education Officer, Moga, Block Moga-I, has made the payment of LTC amounting to ₹16,340/- to the petitioner vide receipt dated 15.06.2016 (Annexure R-2).
