Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 22.09.2016 (Annexure R-1) stands modified entitling the petitioner to the grant of back-wages. He further states that the arrears of the pay of the petitioner have been calculated which comes to ₹14,07,833/- out of which ₹1,40,796/- has been deducted as Contribution towards the New Pension Scheme and ₹4,35,848 has been deducted as income tax which stands deposited with the Income Tax Department. Petitioner, if so advised, may file an appropriate return for refund of the amount which has been deducted in excess from his income.

With these observations, the present contempt petition stands disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.
