The order of the Writ Court mandated a consideration on grant of promotion to the petitioner w.e.f the date when one Sukanya was promoted as Assistant with all consequential benefits in case other conditions of eligibility under the Rules and Government instructions of 70% good ACRs were met.

Respondents have passed the order of promotion but denied order of consequential benefits by relying upon certain judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and this Court.

Be that as it may, respondents cannot be faulted with so as to be proceeded against the provisions of the Contempt of Court's Act.

Rule against the respondent is discharged and the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail the remedies under law.
