Counsel for the respondent states that the order dated 31.07.2015 passed by this Court, contempt of which is alleged, has been duly complied with as the claim of the petitioner has been considered and a speaking order passed on 21.03.2016. This order dated 21.03.2016 has been challenged by the petitioner in CWP No. 9384 of 2016 titled as Mohinder Pal vs. The Punjab State Cooperative Supply and Marketing Federation Ltd. and others, which is now pending consideration before this Court on 08.08.2016.

The proxy counsel appearing for the petitioner states that he is not aware of the facts as per the statement, as has been made by the counsel for the respondent, nor has he got such instructions in this regard.
